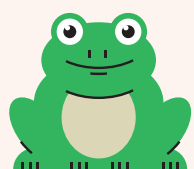
Organise your class into small teams and give each team a print out of the check box in this pack.

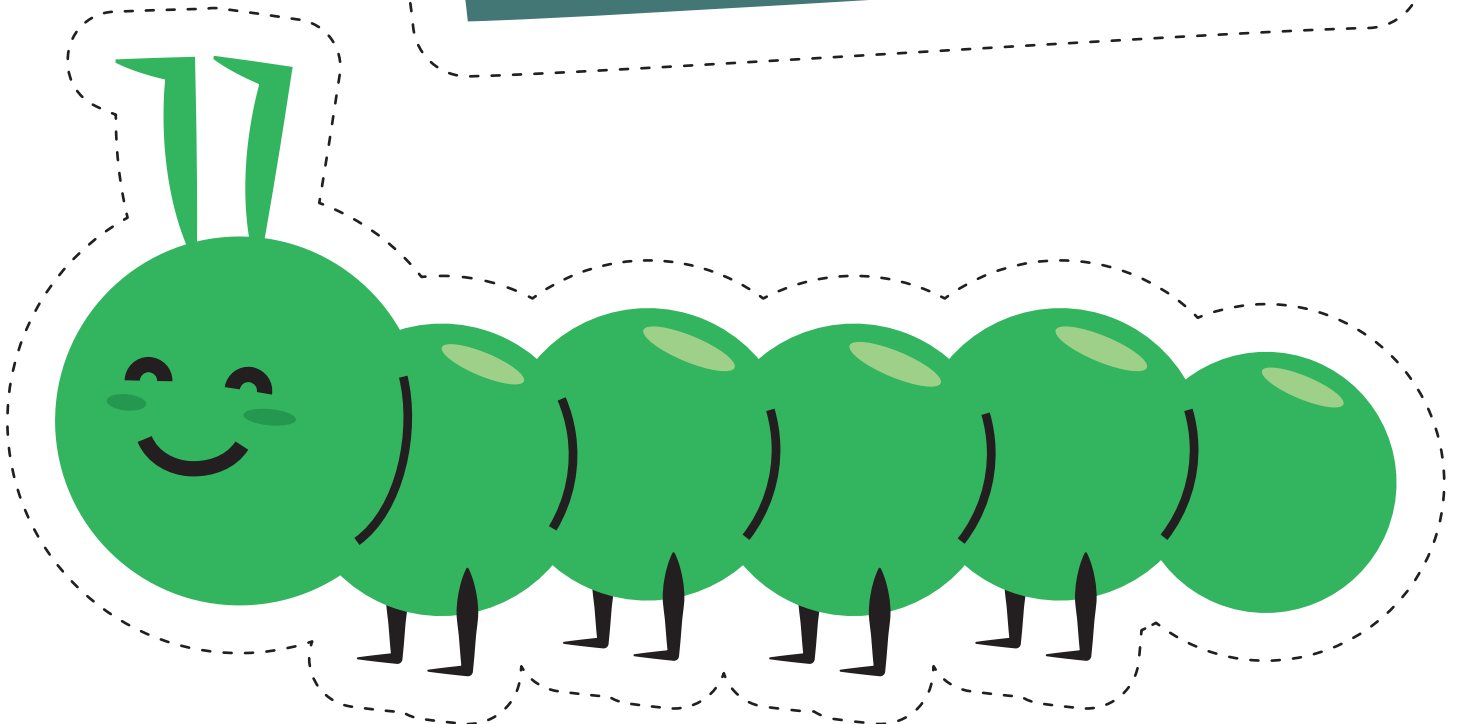
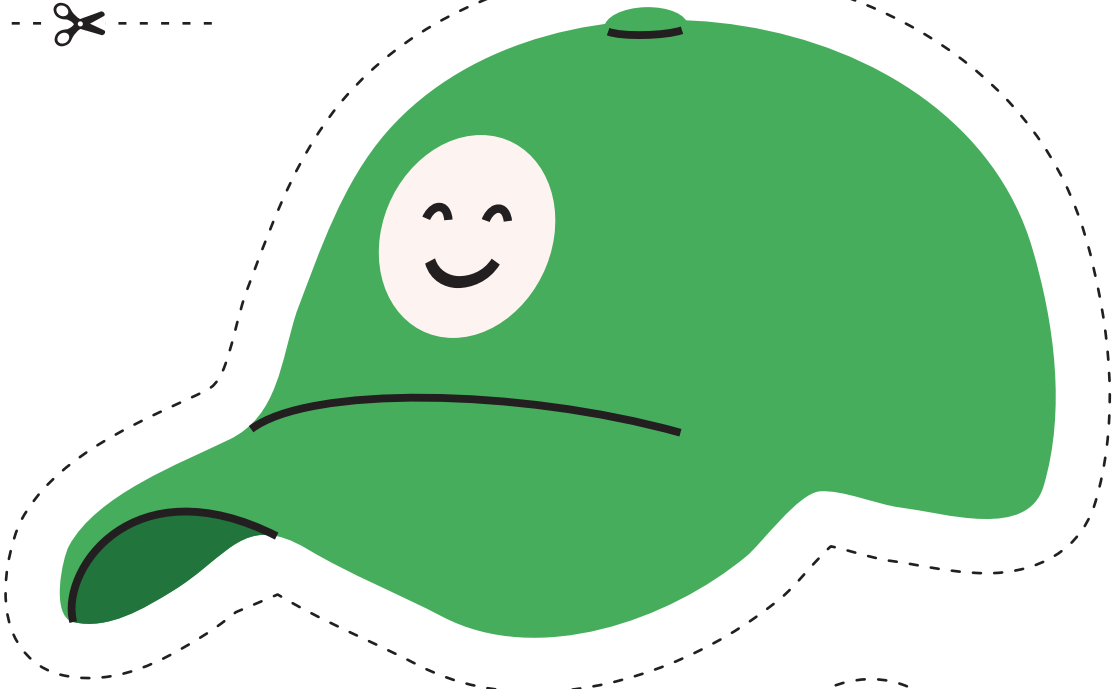
Why not add some clues by each illustration to make it more interesting. We've written some suggested clues in this pack, but you can get creative depending on your school ground or classroom.

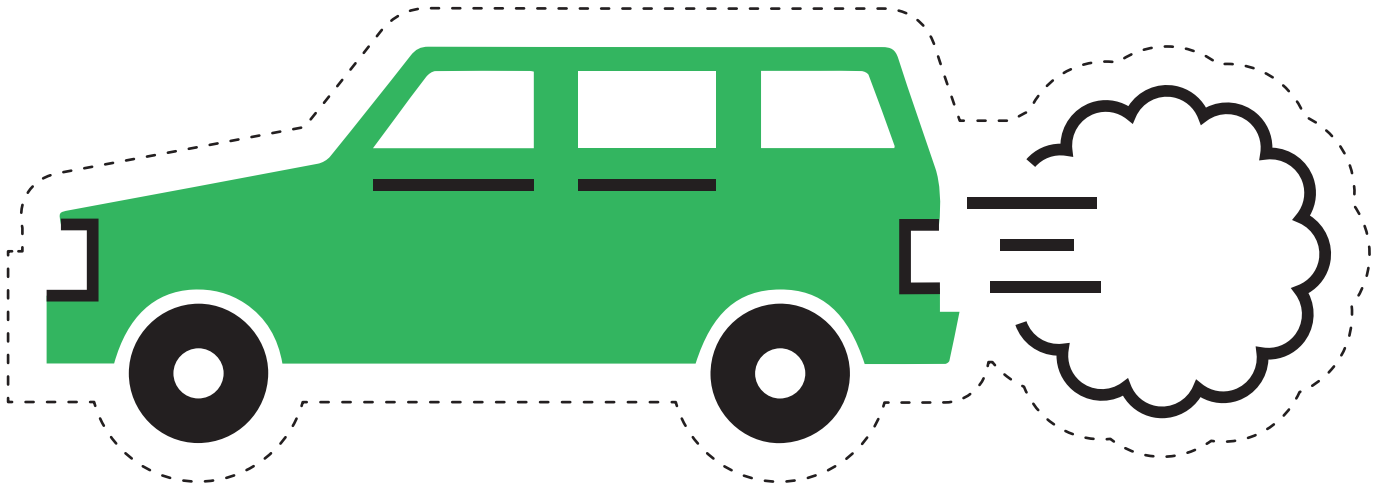

Set a timer and send them out looking for the illustrations – the first team to find each one is the winner. Make sure you have a small prize organised for the winning team.

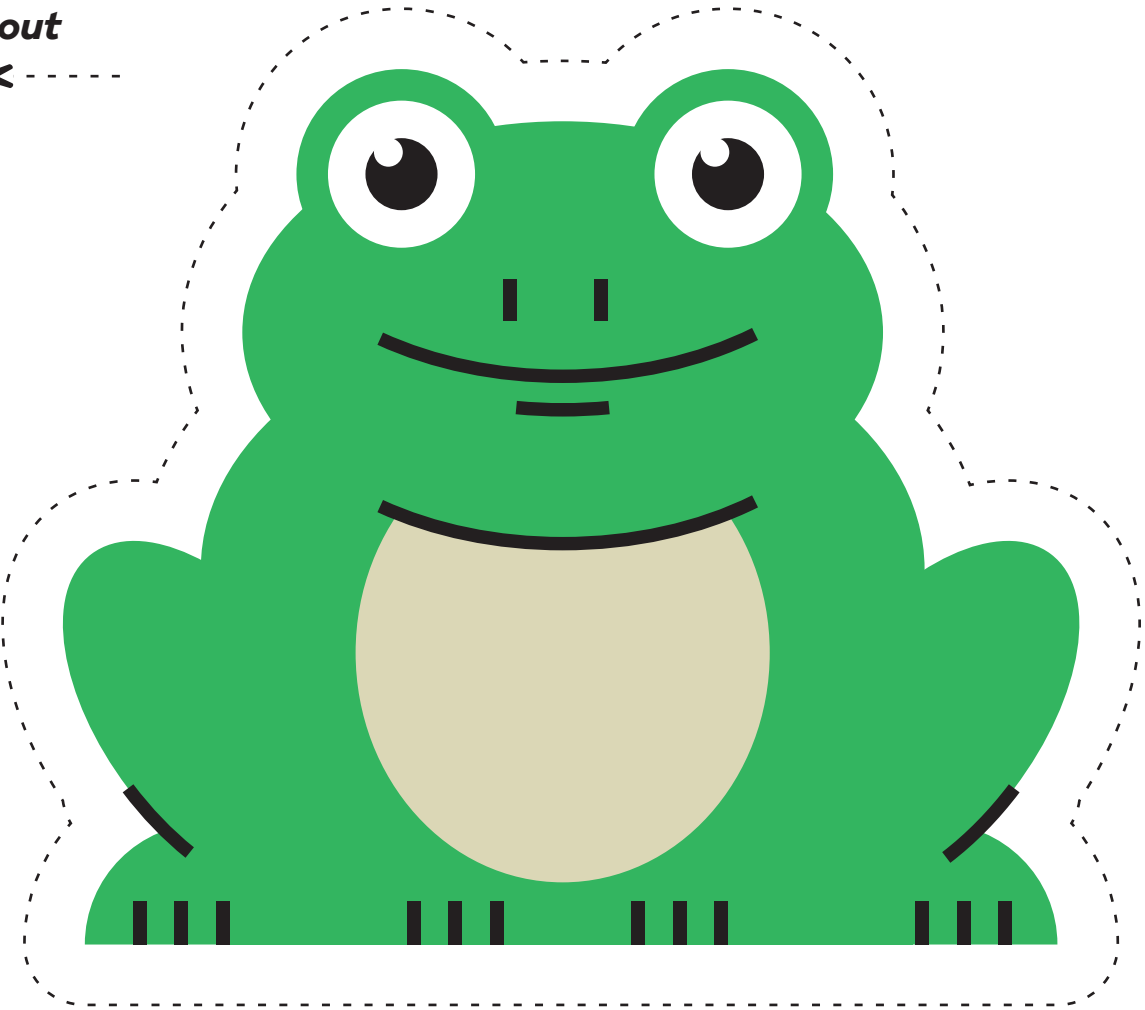

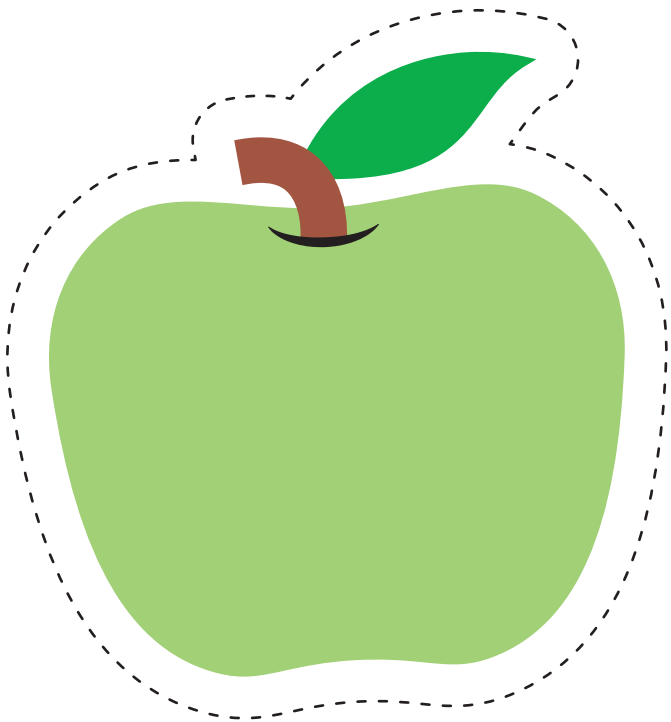

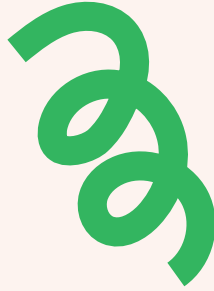


# SOME SUGGESTED CLUES

The next clue can be found where you put your backpack. It could be hook, a locker or even a rack.



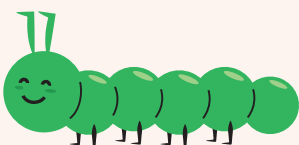
I hold all the words that you need to know. You use me to help your vocabulary grow.



I have hands but no arms and also a face and my hands always move at the same steady pace.

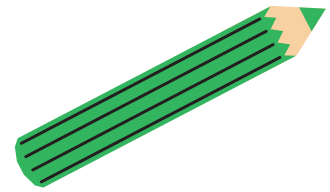


I have four legs but I don't have feet. I come in handy when it's time to eat.
